School Day – Please ensure your child is here by 8.55am ready to be taken into class for registration opening. If your child arrives after 9am a late mark will be given which will negatively impact on your child's attendance record. Can we also ask that you are here promptly at 3.15pm to pick up.

Keeping children safe is a priority. Please ensure children are supervised in the relevant playground until the bell goes at 8.55am when staff will come out and take children into their classes. If at the end of the day someone different is picking up your child please inform the class teacher or school reception.

Uniform – Can we remind parents that pupils should wear black shoes with their uniform. Pupils wearing trainers will be required to change and parents called to bring in alternative footwear. Uniform consists of Grey trousers or skirt, grey tights or white socks, white polo shirt and red cardigan or jumper. Please can we ask that all uniform and bags are named.

School Dinners – North Yorkshire County Catering who currently provide our school meals have increased the cost of a school dinner to £2.30 per day. Please visit North Yorkshire County Council website for further information on this matter and about qualifying for Free School Meals. We would ask parents with children in KS1 (Reception, Year 1 & 2) also visit this page, even though your child is currently receiving a Universal Infant Free School Meal, as a successful claim would result in the school receiving additional funding.

After School Sports Clubs – Sports clubs will be starting on Monday 17th September. A letter is going out to all parents who have retuned forms to confirm which club their child has been allocated. There are still limited spaces left in some classes so if you have not returned your form do so as soon as possible to secure a space. Friday Dance & Gymnastics has been very popular and due to this the class will run on a 6 week cycle which will be explained in the letter to come home.
